In addition to the release of "Change the Tide," Protectors of the Endangered is gearing up for its Earth Day event and upcoming book release in April. In Dec. 2020, the non-profit also joined forces with empath worldwide, a pro bono communications collective and fellow mission-driven organization, to work together on a series of projects in the new year.
